

8. Notice to the Party.—Where the family Court receives any amount payable to a party it shall cause a notice thereof be served on the party concerned within seven days of his applying therefor.

9. Records and Registers of the Family Court.—The records of the Family Court, including its registers, shall be preserved for such period as is provided under the rules of the Supreme Court applicable to Civil Courts.

10. Records and Their Inspection.—

(1) The family Court shall, on the application of any party to a dispute, allow inspection of the records of the family Court relating to the dispute on payment of a fee of forty poisha.

(2) On the application of any party to a suit, certified copies of the Judgment, decree or order or other proceedings or entry in any register maintained under these rules or of any portion thereof shall be supplied on payment of a fee calculated at the rate of forty poisha for one hundred and fifty words or part thereof.

11. Seal of the Family Court—

(1) There shall be kept in the office of every Family Court a seal of the Court which shall be circular in shape and shall have thereon the inscription 'Family Court' and the name of place.

(2) The seal of the Court shall be used on all summons, orders, decrees, copies and other documents issued under the Ordinance or those rules.
